## Main Street Arts Festival

April 16-19, 2026

Fort Worth, TX

The MAIN ST. Fort Worth Arts Festival, presented by PNC Bank, will return to downtown Fort Worth for its 39th year! The stages will also feature performances from jazz artists Marion Meadows, Brian Simpson, and Jessy J, Tejano groups Avizo and Quimikoz del Son, rising country star Tristan Roberson, R&B/soul singer Kenya C, and the ever-popular cover band Poo Live Crew.

Attendees can enjoy a wide array of culinary delights, from Texas barbecue and festival classics to international cuisine, available at multiple food courts. For families, the TCC Makers Zone will provide a variety of hands-on, interactive activities designed to inspire creativity and innovation for all ages, including printmaking, henna and glitter tattoos, foam crafts, sand art, caricatures, and more.
